## 2021 SCHOLARSHIPS ANNOUNCEMENT

GFWC Santa Rosa Woman's Club announces its annual scholarship process. This year, there will be several scholarships offered. The Carolyn Pfeiffer Scholarship is in the amount of \$1500 and honors the late Carolyn Pfeiffer, who was a member for more than 50 years. The two other scholarships are for \$750 each. All scholarships will recognize South Santa Rosa County (Florida) female students with financial or personal hardships who have made a significant impact in their community. The recipients will also have earned academic achievement. The scholarships are open to first time or returning college or vocational/technical students without regard to marital status or full-time or part-time enrollment. Applicants should complete and submit

- the attached application
- at least one letter of recommendation
- a current official transcript
- a copy of the last year's IRS tax return (from the parent or guardian if living at home with social security numbers deleted)

The above information should be **mailed with a postmark on or before March 15, 2021** in a sealed envelope marked "Confidential" to Scholarship Chairman, GFWC Santa Rosa Woman's Club, P.O. Box 423, Gulf Breeze, FL 32561-0423. Any incomplete application or application lacking the requested information will not be considered. "Certified" or "proof of delivery" is encouraged on the part of the sender. All applications received will be acknowledged by email.

Process: Applications received by the **March 15 postmark deadline** with all requested material will be judged "blind" by a selection panel composed of at least five members of the GFWC Santa Rosa Woman's Club. The scholarship recipient will be announced within one month after the deadline. A photograph for press purposes will be requested, and the recipient will be honored at the May or September meeting in Gulf Breeze of the GFWC Santa Rosa Woman's Club.

Scholarship award money is paid directly to the school upon proof of the recipient's enrollment.
