# GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- **CORE CREDITS**

- **English** – 4 credits

- **Math** – 4 credits to include:

**Algebra I, Geometry and two additional math credits**

- **Science** – 3 credits to include:

**Biology and two others. (Keep in mind that most four-year universities want to see four sciences)**

- **Social Studies** – 3 credits to include:

**World History, US History and ½ American Government, ½ Economics**



# CORE CREDITS (Continued)

- **PERFORMING FINE ARTS/PRACTICAL ARTS:**
- **1 credit (Art, Music/Band, Drama, Digital Design, Debate, DIT, etc)**
  
- **PHYSICAL EDUCATION:**
- **1 credit. (Personal Fitness/Fitness Lifestyle Design)**
- **You can waive all of PE with the following:**
  - **Two years of ROTC**
  - **Two seasons of a junior varsity or varsity sport.**
  - **One semester of Marching Band or Colorguard will waive Fitness Lifestyle Design. You can satisfy the remaining ½ credit by taking Personal Fitness online at [www.flvs.net](http://www.flvs.net).**

## **ONLINE course:**

- **1 entire course taken online through FLVS, or DIT course at NHS.**



## **24 TOTAL CREDITS REQUIRED**

### **FOR GRADUATION**

- **8 Elective Credits**
- **World Language is NOT required for graduation.**
- **HOWEVER:**
- **You WILL need two consecutive years of a world language to earn a Bright Futures Scholarship and to be accepted into a Florida university.**
- **A cumulative unweighted grade point average of 2.0 is required**



# Testing Requirements

- **Passing score on the 10th grade FSA ELA Exam**
- **Passing score on the Algebra 1 EOC Exam**
- **Your counselor will provide other testing opportunities for both tests if a passing score is not achieved.**





## CREDIT RECOVERY OPTIONS

- **Florida Virtual School**
- **Entire semester of a course that was originally D or F is repeated.**

- **Highest replacement grade is 100 A.**

- **Highest replacement grade is 75 C**

# • DUAL ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

**Students who wish to participate in the Dual Enrollment program must meet the following conditions:**

- Completion of at least 3 high school credits with a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0
- Earn appropriate scores on all subjects of either the PERT, ACT or SAT
- We recommend students successfully pass Algebra I EOC and FSA/ELA Exam.

• **EVEN IF YOU INTEND TO DUAL ENROLL, YOU WILL STILL NEED TO COMPLETE A HIGH SCHOOL COURSE REQUEST FOR 6 CLASSES. (we can remove your course requests later)**
