

NHS SAC Meeting
February 5, 2019

Meeting was opened at 8am by Mrs. Fischetti.

The meeting proceeded according to the agenda provided:

1. Minutes were read and reviewed. There were no corrections. The minutes were accepted as read.
2. Celebrations: (Mr. Noack)
 - a. Acknowledgment of Ms. Caroline Buechner, NHS Chorus teacher, as the 2020 SRC Teacher of the Year. To be presented and honored at the TOY banquet, Friday, March 1st. We are extremely proud of her!
 - b. NHS Competitive Cheer Team won the 2A State Championship. Well done!
 - c. Industry Certification success! – \$200,000.00 will be awarded to NHS for their testing success in our Industry Certification Programs. NHS ranked #1 in SRC this year with our Academy programs success.
3. SIP Budget vote: (Mrs. Windfelder)
 - a. Only changes recommended were under “Other”: to change the wording from “teacher appreciation” to “employee appreciation”, to include ALL employees and “to include food”
 - b. Motion was made to approve the SIP budget
 - c. SIP Budget was approved and adopted as presented, with the above wording change
4. Guidance: (Mr. Noack & Mrs. Windfelder)
 - a. Staffing – in need of one EBE teacher, one ESE Paraprofessional and one Math teacher (due to military transfer); difficulty comes in finding EBE teacher with all requirements met. Mr. Noack shared what is needed to fill this position.
 - b. Registration –
 - i. Upperclassmen will register before Spring Break
 - ii. Incoming 8th graders will register after Spring Break
 - c. New Education Standards to be implemented – announced by Fl. Governor Ron DeSantis. This will be a process and there is no time line. We will use the present standards until the new ones are in place.
 - d. Spring testing – begins April 3rd & 4th with FSA Writing for 9th & 10 graders. This is a graduation requirement that must be met. Thank you to our English Dept. for their diligence in preparing for this with their students.
5. Student Services: (Mr. Trujillo)
 - a. Discipline updates:
 - i. Graph was provided showing trend in our discipline issues, with “tardies” being the biggest concern.
 - ii. Positive Behavior Interventions are being used to prevent further discipline issues where trends show problems.
 - iii. Type of discipline needed is determined by the nature of the issue.
 - iv. Discussion was held on causes and reasons for a student to be alternately placed at the Learning Academy.

- b. Parking
 - i. Ongoing concern as there is limited parking spaces – work in progress to find alternatives
 - ii. Problem with surrounding neighborhoods and students parking on their property. This is being addressed by our County Commissioner.
 - iii. Shared parking spots is working for DE students
 - iv. Admin is working on a plan for improved parent pickup
- 6. Facilities/ Safety/ Athletics: (Mr. Howell)
 - a. Capital Outlay – handout provided for items submitted for 2019-2020; this is a working document, so items can be added or deleted as the need arises.
 - b. Control Access Doors – security system setup in process; cameras, magnetic front doors & button entry, as well as what’s needed for the gym area; explanation and discussion was held as to the process of how the system will be implemented
 - c. Softball concession stand – building is complete and waiting on final inspection to allow use
- 7. Other:
 - a. Congratulations to Mrs. Fischetti for presenting at the FETC conference
 - b. Job Fair – being held today, Feb. 5th during 1st & 2nd period for 10th – 12th graders that signed up; 32 local vendors will be interviewing students looking for summer work
 - c. Shuttle Astronaut Don Thomas visited NHS Jan. 31st. Speaking to over 500 students, with a special visit to our ESE students and lunch with our Science and Math teachers.
 - d. WNIS Valentine Dance, Feb. 15 – fundraiser for NHS students, volunteers needed
 - e. Thank you to Ms. Lacy Allen, Military Liaison from HAFB, for arranging for staff from the base to present an upcoming workshop on suicide prevention

There was no further business to be discussed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:57.
